PUBLIC NOTICE

DRONE OPERATIONS AWARENESS

In accordance with MCTTT, Phase 2 of Covid Safe Economic Recovery Framework, Public gatherings are allowed under certain requirements:

Outdoors:

- Within your own bubble
- Well ventilated spaces with 2 metres physical distancing
- Use of PPE such as face covering
- Maintain records of contact tracing and download careFIJI app with Bluetooth on mobile at all times

If you are a recreational drone pilot and wish to operate a drone, you are advised to operate within the above-mentioned restrictions that are still in place.

You cannot fly your drone over public spaces such as parks or the beach, or your neighbor's premises during curfew.

Drone Registration and Authorisations are mandatory for all drone owners/users in Fiji. Recreational drone users must complete form OP 137, available on <u>www.caaf.org.fj</u> and emailed to <u>drones@caaf.org.fj</u>.

Operating a drone apart from any recreational purpose is a Commercial Activity, therefore requiring written authorization from the Authority (CAAF). Email the authority for requirements to attain a Commercial Authorisation.

If in doubt, STAY GROUNDED – it's the safest thing to do.
