LANDING OVER-RUN ACCIDENTS CAN BE AVOIDED BY:

 Recognising the existence of these main contributing factors, any one of which will increase landing distance considerably:

Approach speed too fast

Tailwind component

Height at threshold too high

•Wet and greasy surface

Obstacles on the approach

Poor braking action

- Deciding early whether to continue or abort the approach or landing
- 3. Executing immediate and correct go-around action when necessary (obstacles and terrain permitting)
- Avoiding airstrips that are beyond the capabilities of you and your aircraft type
