

NOTICE TO ALL AVIATION STAKEHOLDERS

The Civil Aviation Authority of Fiji (CAAF) is seeking industry feedback on proposed amendments to the Standards Document for Airworthiness of Aircraft Part 2 (ICAO Requirements).

The Standards Document - Airworthiness of Aircraft Part 2 (ICAO Requirements) aligns with the latest provisions of ICAO Annex 8 Airworthiness of Aircraft, including Amendment 110.

Amendment 110 relates to the following:

Amendment 110 arises from recommendations of the eighteenth meeting of the Remotely Piloted Aircraft Systems Panel (RPASP/18) regarding international remotely piloted aircraft systems (RPAS) operations in controlled airspace/aerodromes. The amendment introduces an update to Standards related to remotely piloted aircraft systems (RPAS) consequential to provisions in the newly adopted Annex 6, Part IV.

The applicability date for this amendment is 26 November 2026.
